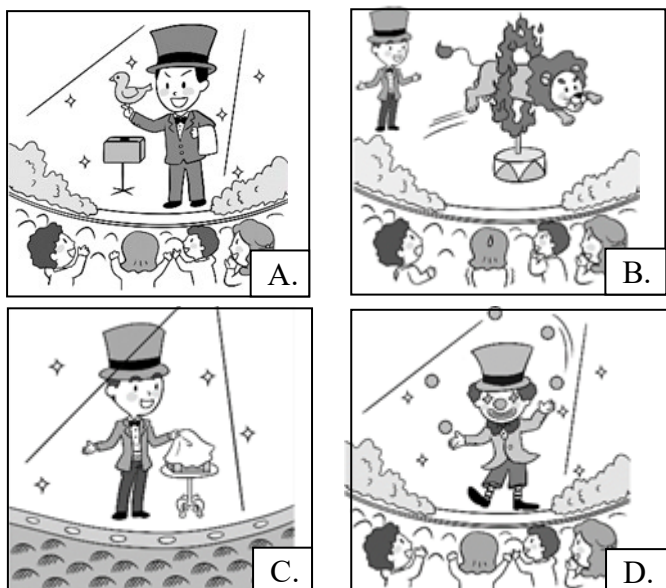

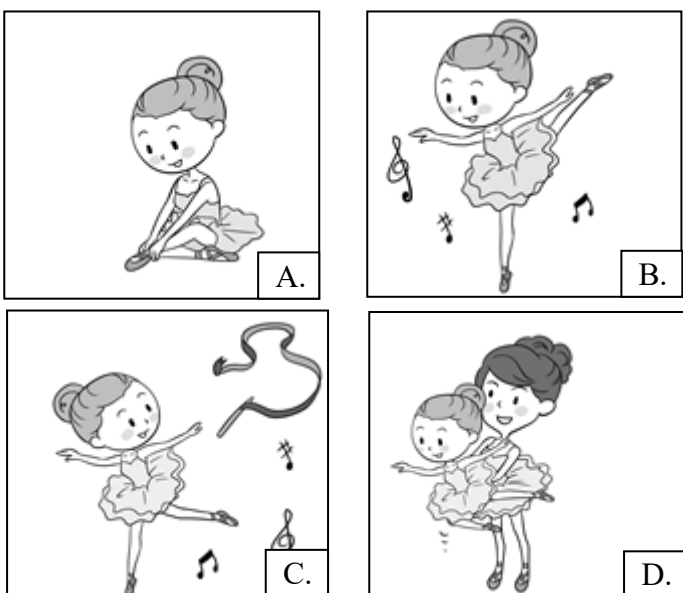

Some animals are amazing because of their speed, fast movement, or other special abilities\*. One special animal, the *Alpine swift*, has all three.

*Alpine swifts* are migratory\* birds that spend their summers in Europe and their winters in Africa. By studying their flying paths\* between Europe and Africa, scientists discovered that these fast birds can fly up to 72 kilometers per hour. They also have enough power to fly for over six months without ever touching land.

To keep these flying modes\*, the birds eat and sleep while in the air. Their food includes small bugs and other things staying in the sky. The liquid inside their food gives them enough water to survive. Besides, twice a day, once in the early morning and once in the evening, *Alpine swifts* fly to a height of about 10,000 feet. Scientists think the birds fly this high so that they can take a quick nap while they slowly go down.

*Alpine swifts* have also been watched to go into sleep mode to save energy\*. They do this when they come across bad weather or short of food. Although they're very small in size, *Alpine swifts* are truly quite amazing!

As a busy 9th grader, you must have had the experience of burning the midnight oil before tests. Yet, if you don't sleep for a long time, more than just your test scores may get worse.

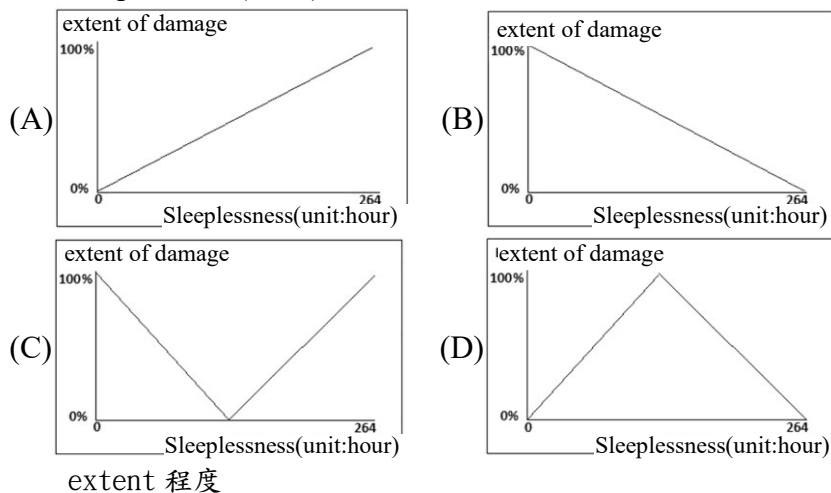
It is reported that a 17-year-old high school student, Randy Gardner, didn't sleep for 264 hours, or 11 days. He did so as a "test" in order to study how he would act without sleep. His eyes lost focus on day two. Then he was not able to identify\* things, and he felt down and became all thumbs. By the end of the "test", he had trouble focusing, memorizing, and judging between which is real and which is not.

Although he got well without physical damage, he could have been affected badly.

According to doctors, enough sleep can allow the brain's "cleaner" CSF(腦脊液) to enter the brain to clean up waste and help to increase brain\* health. More CSF can clear more waste products\* in the brain. If those waste products are not cleared away, they can fill and hurt the brain. Then, many bad symptoms\* of not getting enough sleep appear.
