Who was the first person to have the idea of the rear-view mirror? Dorothy Elizabeth was. She was the first woman driver in the car race. When the cars came out in the early 1900s, only a few men could drive. Women had 39 chances of practicing driving. Even driving teachers were not willing to teach women to drive. However, at that time Dorothy Elizabeth learned about driving and joined car races. She tried very hard and wanted to show one thing to the world—women could drive as well as men could. In 1905, Dorothy Elizabeth set the record for the longest drive from London to Liverpool and became 40 woman racing driver in the world. It was not easy for her because the car racing drivers also had to know the ways to fix the race cars. Besides, Dorothy also taught Queen Alexandra and Royal Princesses how to drive. Cirillo found himself more focused with the help of the timer by chance, and now the Pomodoro Technique is widely used in the world. It helps people better manage their time to get things done. There are 6 steps in the Pomodoro Technique:

1. List the things you have to finish.
2. Set your timer for 25 minutes.
3. Start working.
4. When the timer rings, whether you have finished or not, stop and leave a mark on your list.
5. Take a short break for 5-10 minutes.
6. After 4 Pomodoro timers, take a longer break for about 15-30 minutes.

If you find that you can keep working for more than 25 minutes, you are free to set for a longer time. The key is to stay fully focused when you work. Also, make sure you don't do anything about your work when taking a break. Things like taking a walk or having a cup of tea are all good ideas. Just remember, when using the Pomodoro Technique, "stay focused" both when you work and when you rest.
