A *wooden boy, Pinocchio, each time he lied, his nose grew longer. The engineers from the University of Granada have found-- though our noses' sizes won't increase like Pinocchio when we tell a lie, our noses' temperatures will. And they called this "the Pinocchio *Effect".

With the help of *thermographic cameras, the engineers found when we lie, we become nervous, and our *facial temperatures increase.

In fact, we can't carry around the special cameras to check people's honesty or to touch people's noses to know if they are lying. However, there are other ways to detect lies, and one of them is through body language. When your conversation partner can't be calm, he covers his mouth and touches his nose. If someone looks away often while talking, he may have something to hide.

UberEats is convenient and useful, and you can pay by credit card even in smaller cities. Postmates lets you know if your meal is on the way.
