When you travel to another country, a foreigner might invite you to his or her house. It is not easy to bring a gift to the host, is it? Because "WHAT to give" and "HOW to give a gift" are both important.

The tradition of gift giving has been around for quite a long time. Cultures of giving gifts are different from country to country. Take Japan for example. Japanese pay more attention to the gift-giving than the gift itself. Giving "four or nine" of something means unlucky. Be sure to give pairs. In Saudi Arabia, only give gifts to the closest friends. Give gifts with the highest quality and never buy gold or silk as a present for men.

On the other hand, though in France, a bottle of wine for a dinner party is not a creative idea because the host might have prepared one, but it is fine to do so in Sweden. And in Argentina, one should not give clothing, knives or scissors as presents because of the meaning of cutting off the relationship. You might think about giving chocolate as a present. Don't do that in Belgium. If you really have decided on that, be sure to give the high quality chocolate because people in Belgium are famous as chocolate experts. Like Chinese, people in Denmark like presents wrapped in red. White is not their cup of tea. And for those in Norway, buying gifts is never interesting to them except on Christmas because there is no gift-giving culture there.

Giving gifts is really a difficult lesson to learn, right? When you know more about it, you can be a perfect visitor to the host.
